The Malvern Anglican Parish had another successful fundraising day on Saturday, 20 September. In total, the fair raised around \$3,500 which is similar to last year.



We had lots of support from our parishioners both from MAP and the MCP, for which we are extremely grateful. The weather was bright and the blustery wind didn't worsen over the morning. We had more stalls than usual - we couldn't squeeze any more tables inside and there were 12 outdoor stalls, with a few new outdoor additions including two stalls for children and Darfield Menz Shed. Tremendous amounts of baking and preserves arrived from around the parish as usual, though plant donations were noticeably fewer than previous years. We also ran our sausage sizzle, books, puzzles and linen stalls.

For the first time, we made use of some teenage power—with help from Darfield High School sports students setting up on Friday and Darfield Scouts helped clean up and re-organise the furniture at the end. Thank you again to those who helped on the day or sent baking and plants to sell, but also to everyone who came and supported the event—*Alison Gray*
